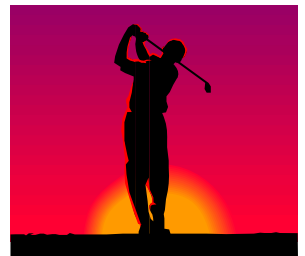

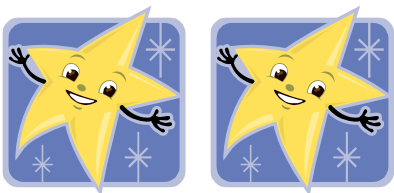

About The Tournament

The *John Webb Winter Golf Tournament* was founded in January of 2003 by friends of John Webb, Sr. to honor his memory. John Webb, Sr., a music educator in Escambia County for 25 years died in 2001 from a heart attack.



His children, Janet, John Jr., and James, decided to dedicate the proceeds of the tournament to Sacred Heart Children's Hospital through their Child Life Program to buy video games, puzzles, art supplies and other diversions for the children facing life-threatening illnesses. Although James died in 2004 from cancer at the age of 17, the tournament continues on to honor James' memory and to help other children and their families.

Starting in 2003 with just 30 participants and \$8887 in proceeds, the golf tournament has continued to grow, with nearly \$30,000 in total proceeds to date. Donation monies have purchased two flat screen TVs, age-appropriate games, movies, books, craft supplies, and more for infants, children, and teens.

Today, the *John Webb Winter Golf Tournament* tradition continues through the generous corporate and community support, and the tireless dedication of family and friends. John Webb, Jr., a professional baseball player, invites his fellow professional athletes (men and women) to join him every year to support the tournament and raise money for the children at Sacred Heart.



James Webb Courage in Life Award

Since 2005, the *James Webb Courage in Life Award* has been given to the largest single corporate donation and the golf team with the largest "pot" of donation monies. James Webb was an accomplished high school musician and praise and worship leader in his church. A team of James' friends have played in the tournament and won the team award every year, collecting a total of \$2600 in his honor.
